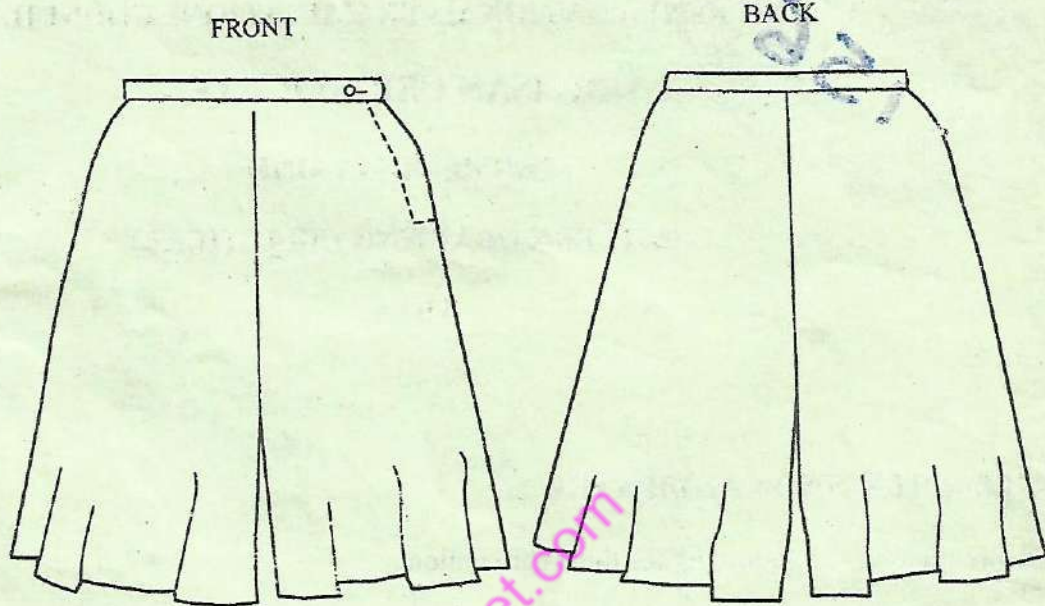

Measurements

Waist	-	70 cm
Hips	-	94 cm
Waist to hips	-	20.6 cm
Body rise	-	28 cm
Culottes length	-	45 cm
