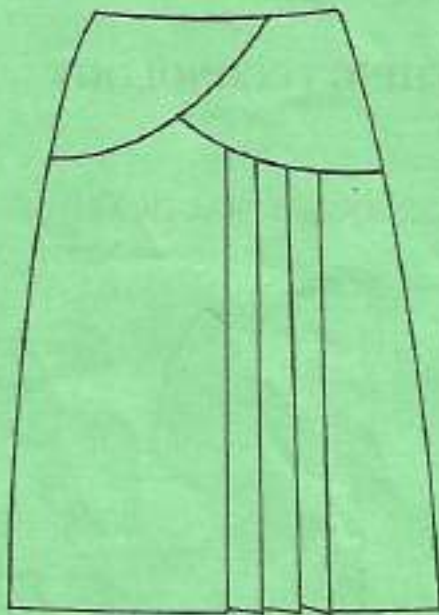
TASKS

(78 $\frac{1}{2}$ marks)



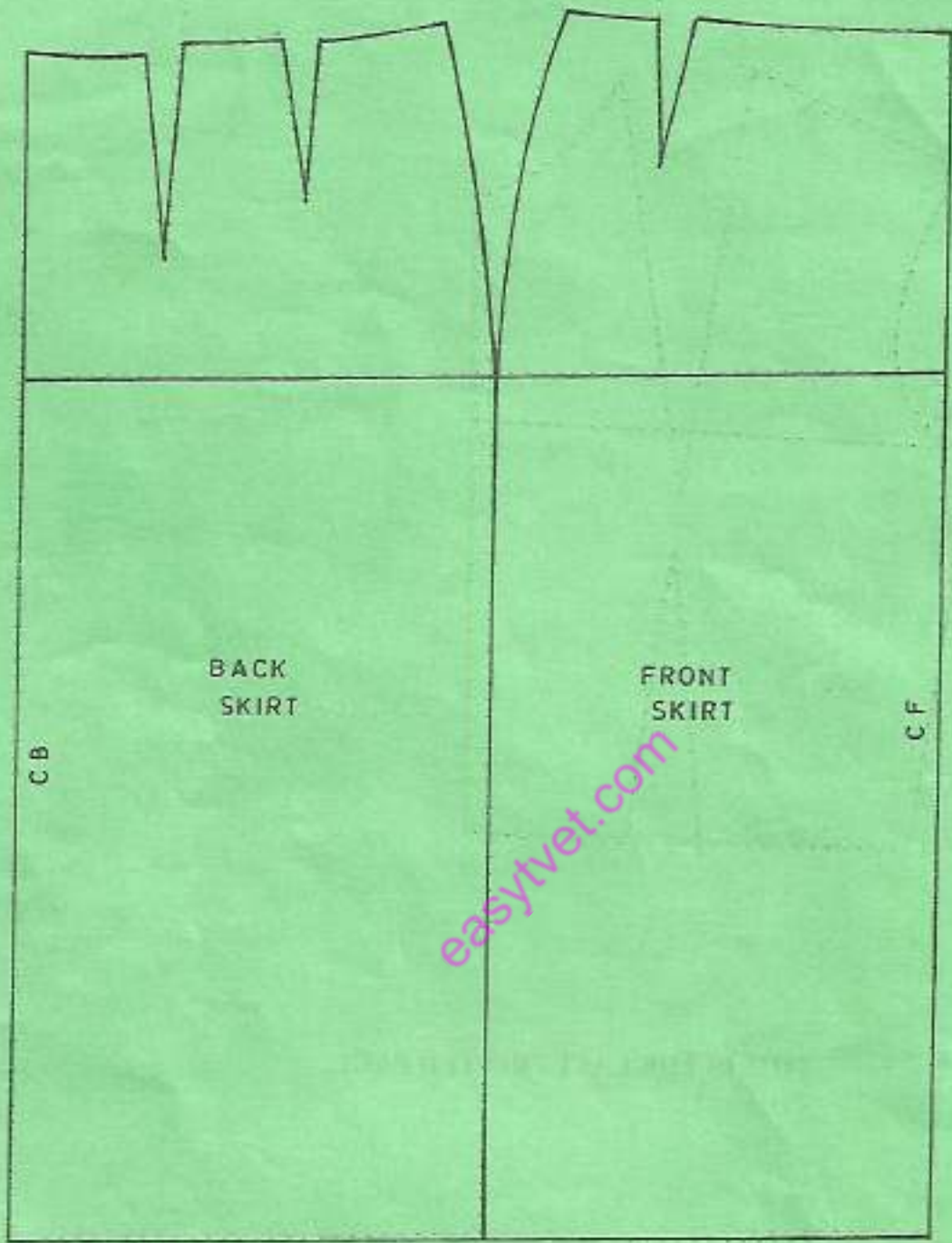
FRONT VIEW



BACK VIEW

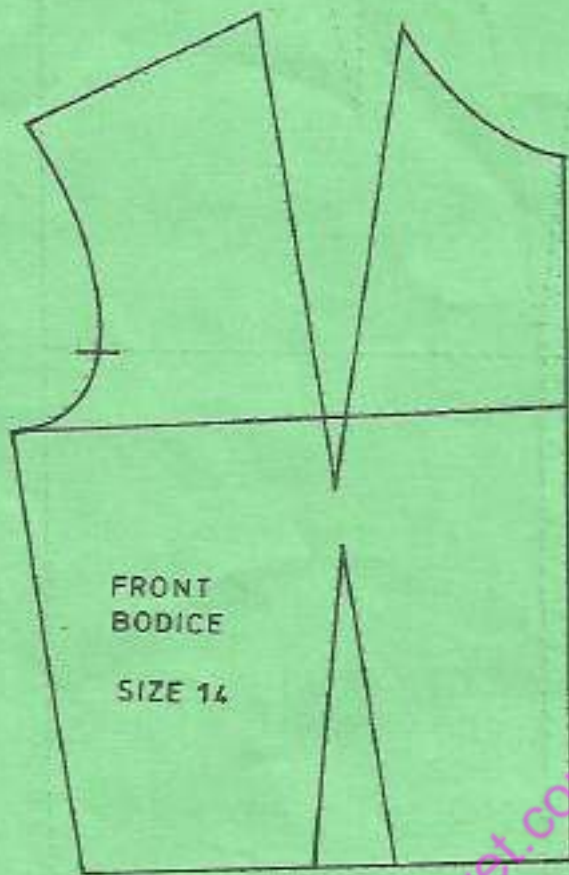
NB:
