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TASK 1

- (a) Open a desktop publishing program and make the following default settings:
 - (i) page orientation: landscape (½ mark)
 - (ii) paper size : A4. (½ mark)
- (b) Create the publication to appear as shown in sample 1, ensuring that the design covers the entire printable part of the page on an A4 paper. (18 marks)

- (c) (i) Save the publication as *offer* in the **KNECEXAM** folder. (½ mark)
- (ii) Print out later the publication. (½ mark)

TASK 2

- (a) Open a CAD program and set millimetres as the default units. (1 mark)
- (b) Insert **two** layers each with the following properties:
- (i) A layer labelled *body* with the line weight set to 0.8 mm on which to draw the geometry; (1 mark)
 - (ii) A layer labelled *dimension* with the line weight set to 0.18 mm and of a red colour on which to draw the dimensions. (1 mark)
- (c) (i) Draw on the layer named *body*, the geometry shown in figure 1 using the dimensions indicated. (11 marks)
- (ii) Fully dimension the geometry as it appears on the layer labelled *dimension*. (4½ marks)
- (d) Save the drawing as *metal plate* in the **KNECEXAM** folder to print out later. (1½ marks)

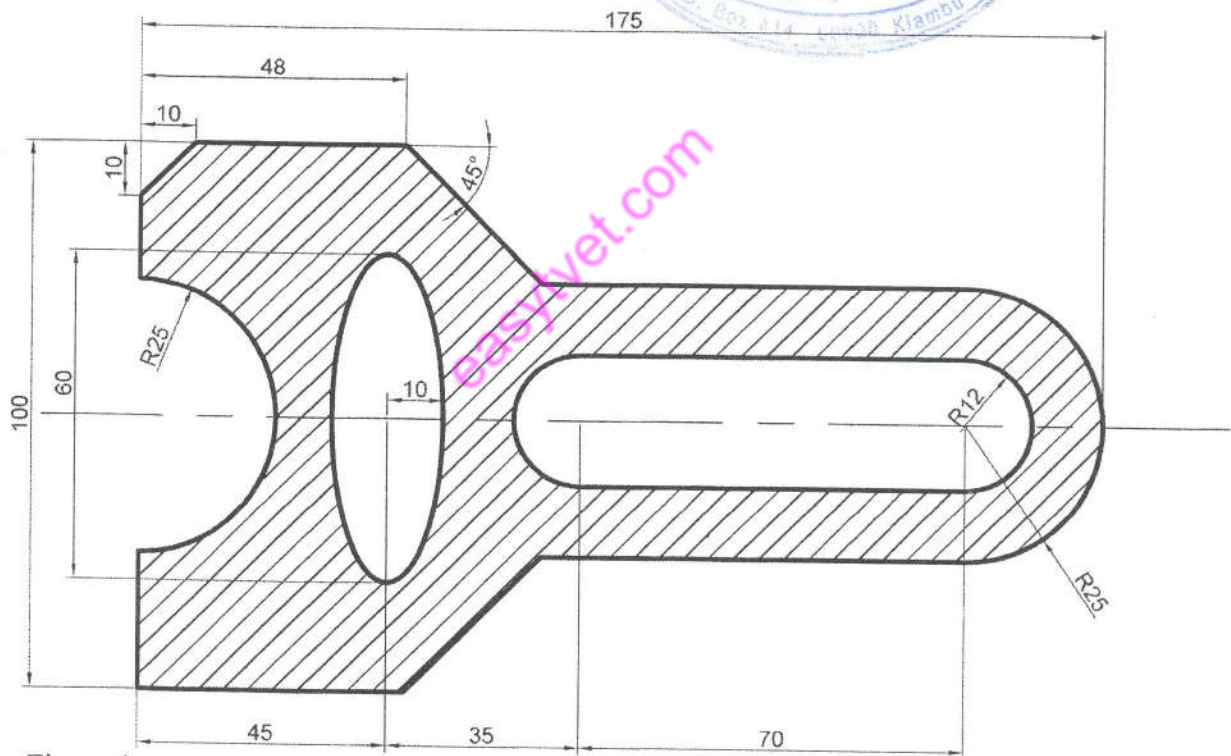

TASK 3

Halima Fatuma of Kilifi is a farmer who sells her produce to villagers and also supplies to hotels around the area. Open a suitable accounting program and record the following financial details and transactions relating to her farming business for the six months starting from 1st July 2014.

During the six months period ending on 31st December 2014, the following transactions took place:

July 30 th	Incurred the following expenses - Ksh 60,000 for ploughing the land, Ksh 50,000 for seeds, Ksh 20,000 for fertilizer all on credit from Kilifi Farmers SACCO;
August 10 th	Bought a new greenhouse kit Ksh 120,000 by cheque;
August 15 th	Received payments by cheque from Kilifi Creek Hotel Ksh 100,000
August 30 th	Sold vegetables to Kilifi Creek Hotel Ksh 48,000 on credit;
Sept 10 th	Received Ksh 60,000 from Kilifi Cashewnut Factory by cash;
Sept 20 th	Labour for greenhouse preparation Ksh 5,000 paid by cash;
Sept 30 th	Expenses paid by cheque:- Seeds Ksh 25,000 and fertilizer Ksh 30,000;
October 10 th	Sold vegetables to New Kilifi Bay Hotel Ksh 36,000 on credit;
Nov 24 th	Paid SACCO loan interest Ksh 10,000 by cash;
Nov 28 th	Paid Kilifi Farmers SACCO Ksh 100,000 by cheque;

The following are average monthly cash revenues and expenses;

- I. Cash Sales
 - Vegetables Ksh 10,000,
 - Milk Ksh 2,000,
 - Animal feeds Ksh 3,000
- II. Cash expenses
 - Electricity Ksh 1,300,
 - Wages Ksh 9,200,
 - Water Ksh 800.
