 - (e) brown papers;
 - (f) large envelope;
 - (g) one button 1.5 cm wide without a shank;
 - (h) interfacing 30 x 60 cm wide.
- II. At the end of this examination:
 - (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.

TASK

- Using the bodice, sleeve blocks and the measurement provided, cut out and make the garment style sketched below as follows:
 - (i) use open plain seems at the sides and under arm seams;
 - (ii) use plain closed seems at the panels;
 - (iii) use separate facing for the back opening;
 - (iv) under stitch the facings;
 - (v) finish the sleeve hem using bias binding;
 - (vi) work a button and a buttonhole at the neckline.

MEASUREMENTS

Full length - 100 cm
Collar depth - 7 cm
Sleeve width/girth - 27 cm
