 - (c) Fusible interfacing 50 cm by 30 cm.
 - (f) One zip 7 inches long.
 - (g) A pair of cutting shears.
 - (h) A pair of paper cutting scissors.
 - Tape measure.
 - (j) Drafting tools.
 - (k) Cellotape,
 - (l) Sewing tools.
 - (m) One button 1.5 cm wide without a shank.
 - (n) Bias binding $2\frac{1}{2}$ metres long to match the fabric.
 - (o) One large envelope.

TASK

- (a) Using the bodice blocks, sleeves blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns required for the garment style sketched below.
- (b) Using the prepared patterns, cut out and make the garment as follows:
 - (i) use plain open seams;
 - (ii) make an extended facing;
 - (iii) slip hem the sleeves;
 - (iv) bind the hem;
 - (v) make a button hole and stitch on the button at the break point.
 - NB: Spend minimal time on pattern preparation.

MEASUREMENTS:

Sleeve length - 27 cm Sleeve width - 28 cm Full length - 100 cm



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
