 - (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any detail.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.


TASKS

Using the 'flat' shirt and sleeve blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the dust coat style below.

NB: Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.

Using the materials and the prepared patterns, cut out and make the garment as follows:

- (a) Use plain closed seams at the shoulders, sides and sleeve back seam.
- (b) Top stitch the seams.
- (c) Make one hand worked buttonhole at the break point and sew on the button.
