TASK

1. Using the flat overgarment, sleeve block and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the boy's bathrobe style sketched below.

 - (a) Use plain closed seam at the shoulders, sides and underarm.
 - (b) Hand hem the garment.

NB: Make a single yoke.


Measurements
