 - (c) Sewing thread to match the fabric.
 - (d) Fusible interfacing 40 cm by 60 cm.
 - (e) One button without shank 1.5 cm wide.
 - (f) Brown papers.
 - (g) sewing tools.
 - (h) A large envelope.
- At the end of the examination:
 - (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing details.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the envelope.

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TASK


 Using the bodice, sleeve and skirt blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns required for the blouse style sketched below.

N.B.

- Back facing is extended.
- Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.
- Using the materials provided and the prepared patterns, cut out and make the garment as follows:
 - (a) use plain open seams at shoulders, underarms and sides;
 - (b) make one button hole and attach the button at back neck.

MEASUREMENTS:

Full length - 64 cm
Sleeve length - 20 cm
Pocket width - 9 cm
Welt depth - 2.5 cm
Waist - 66 cm





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
