- 8. Tracing wheel.

SECTION A: BATIK (60 marks)

1. Using the free-hand waxing techniques and repeat pattern techniques, produce a batik fabric with patterns as shown below.



SECTION B: EMBROIDERY (40 marks)

- 2. Trace out the motif provided and embroider as follows
 - Use zigzag stitches for the stems, leaves and the flower.
 - Use straight stitches for veins.

N.B: Use different colours of thread.



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
