BATIK

1. Cotton fabric (40 cm x 40 cm);
2. Old newspapers;
3. Pencil;
4. Paraffin wax;
5. Beeswax;
6. Stove/charcoal jiko;
7. Saucepan / sufuria / metallic tin;
8. VAT dyes;
9. Sodium hydrosulphite;
10. Caustic soda;
11. Stirring rod;
12. Small bucket;
13. Measuring jar;
14. Tablespoon;
15. Iron;
16. Large sufuria/pot;
17. Liquid detergent / bar soap;
18. Hand gloves;
19. Nose mask.

EMBROIDERY

1. Poplin fabric (35 cm by 53 cm);
2. Assorted hand embroidery thread;
3. Thimble;
4. Hand sewing needles;
5. Tracing paper;
6. Tailor's chalk;
7. Embroidery hoop;
8. Machine embroidery thread (assorted colours);
9. Trimming / embroidery scissors;
10. Dressmaker's carbon paper.

SECTION A: BATIK

Using the free-hand waxing technique, produce a fabric with wavy lines, straight lines and circles.

SECTION B: EMBROIDERY

Trace out the motif provided and embroider the fabric as follows:

- (i) using the stem and feather hand stitches, outline the leaves and the stem of the motif as labelled;
- (ii) fill in the flower petals using machine stitches.
