<b>TASK: DEWORMING A CALF</b>			
1. Wore PPEs (dust coat, gumboots, gloves and face mask). <i>(Award ½ mark for each PPE donned as per workplace procedures)</i>	<b>2</b>		
2. Assembled materials, tools and equipment as per work place procedures <i>(Award 2marks for assembling in advance)</i>	<b>2</b>		
3. Restrained the calf well to ensure the calf is calm and not jumpy in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2 mark for appropriate restraining of the calf)</i>	<b>2</b>		
4. Placed the weighing tape over the calf's back just behind the front legs to measure the heart girth in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2 mark for placing the tape and 2 marks for measuring the heart girth)</i>	<b>4</b>		
5. Ensured the calf's head is up and the calf is standing squarely on the ground in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2 mark for ensuring the calf is upright)</i>	<b>2</b>		

6. Ensured the weighing tape is in contact with the calf's body surface all the way round in accordance with the livestock production manual. <i>(Award 2 marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		
7. Read the weight estimation on the scale of the tape when the calf is still in accordance with the livestock production manual. <i>(Award 2 marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		
8. Recorded the weight of the calf in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 3 mark for correctly recording the identity of the calf, weight and the date of weighing)</i>	<b>3</b>		
9. Read the instructions and measured the correct amount of dewormer. <i>(Award 2 mark for reading and 1 mark for measuring)</i>	<b>3</b>		
10. Opened the calf's mouth gently in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2 marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		
11. Placed the syringe/drenching gun on the side of the animal's mouth over the tongue base towards the back of the throat. in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2marks for placing syringe on the side, 2marks for holding the tongue firm)</i>	<b>4</b>		
12. Slightly raised the head of the calf steadily and squeezing the plunger making sure the goat swallows in accordance with the livestock production manual <i>(Award 2marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		

13. Recorded the name/identity of the calf, weight, the type of dewormer used, the amount of dewormer used and date of deworming (Award 1 mark for each correct information recorded)	<b>4</b>
