Task 1: Install and Configure Chrome browser

You are provided with a computer installed with an operating system. The owner of the computer wishes to access internet resources using a well configured Google chrome browser.

- a. Download chrome browser from a trusted source
- b. Install the downloaded chrome browser
- c. Using a password manager interface, set a password for the installed browser
- d. Activate developers mode of the installed browser
- e. Test the functionality of the configuration made to the chrome browser.

Task 2: Create bootable of windows OS

In this task you are required to run an internet browser and perform the following activities as per your system specification

- a. Download a software for creating USB bootable
- b. Install the downloaded software in (a) above
- c. Determine the given Windows Operating system image specification
- d. Determine computer system specification.
- e. Create a bootable using any appropriate method as per your system specification
- f. Test the created bootable USB
