INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE:

You are required to perform the following TWO tasks

Task 1- Demonstrating knowledge and skills in using the internet

- a) Create a folder named **Practical_Internet** on the desktop to store all the work done in this paper.
- b) Locate the public IP address of the computer, screen capture it, and save it as **Public_IP** in the **Practical Internet** folder.

- c) Open the Chrome browser and perform the following settings.
 - i Change the default search engine to DuckDuckGo.
 - ii Set the browser's search engine shortcut to open in a new tab.
- d) Set the font size to large.
- e) Apply a dark theme color to the chrome browser.
- f) Disable the first TWO Chrome extensions that are currently enabled.
- g) Set the download directory for the Chrome browser to the **Practical_Internet** folder.
- h) Enable the bookmarks bar on the browser.
- i) Search for **Wildbeast** on Google, filter the search to show only images, download one image, and save it in the **Practical_Internet** folder as **Wildbeast_image**. (3 Marks)

Task 2- Email communication

- a) Log into your email account (use any available email service such as Gmail, Yahoo, Outlook etc.
- b) Compose an email with the following details:
 - i Address it to your own email address.
 - ii Use **Proposal for a Maasai Mara Visit** as the subject.
 - iii Cc your own email address.
 - iv In the body of the email, type the following message:

Dear Sir/Madam.

I am writing to propose an exciting educational trip to the Maasai Mara National Reserve.

The visit will offer participants the opportunity to:

- Witness the Great Wildebeest Migration
- Learn about the Maasai culture and heritage
- Experience breathtaking wildlife and scenery

- d) Screen capture the email composition window, ensuring that the email is visible. Save the screenshot as **Email_Composition** in the **Practical_Internet** folder.

- e) Zip the **Practical_Internet** folder (containing the screenshots and attachments) and attach it to the email.
- f) Send the email to yourself.
- g) Once you have received the email, capture a screenshot of the inbox showing the received email. Paste this screenshot into a **WordPad** document.
- h) Save the WordPad document as **Email_Received** in the **Practical_Internet** folder.
