<b>Task 3: Install floor tiles on an area of 1.0 m x 1.0 m on the plastered side of the wall.</b>			
8. Used a trowel to spread the grout in a small section onto the floor when laying tiles <i>(Award 1 mark for every three tiles correctly laid) (Award 1 mark for each 3x 1mark= 3 Marks)</i>	<b>3</b>		
9. Laid the tiles and set into place using plastic spacers to maintain consistency in the design. <i>(Award 4 marks for correct procedure= 4 Marks)</i> <i>(Award 2 marks for correct use of spacers= 2 Marks.)</i>	<b>6</b>		
10. Removed the spacers carefully when the grout began to set. <i>(Award 2 marks for correct removal of spacers=2 Marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		
11. Removed excess material on the tiles by wiping them off. <i>(Award two marks for excess removal of grout = 2 Marks)</i>	<b>2</b>		
12. Cleaned all tools used during the practical <i>(Award two marks for cleaning of at least four tools used= 2 Marks)</i>	<b>2</b>
